SUBJECT: Proposed Fiscal Year 2023 Amended Budget

RECOMMENDATION/MOTION: Recommend that the proposed Fiscal Year 2024 Budget be accepted and placed on file for a 30-day review period.

BACKGROUND: Township Code (60 ILCS 1/80-60) requires the Township board to comply with Illinois Municipal Budget Law.

Illinois Municipal Budget Law (50 ILCS 330/3) states that the Township Board of Trustees shall prepare and adopt a combined annual budget and appropriation ordinance within or before the first quarter of each fiscal year. In addition, Property Tax Code (35 ILCS 200/2-30) requires the Township Assessor to prepare and present an operations budget at least 60 days prior to the beginning of each fiscal year.

The law further states that the budget in tentative form shall be made available for public inspection for at least 30 days and at least one public hearing shall be held prior to final action, notice of which shall be given by publication in an English language newspaper in the township at least 30 days prior to the time of the hearing and subsequent action.

To ensure compliance with the various statutes, the City of Bloomington Township sets forth the following timeline:

- January 23, 2023 Present the proposed budget to the Board of Trustees
- January 24, 2023 Publish in the Pantagraph notice of the public hearing and availability of the tentative budget
- February 27, 2023 Hold the Public Hearing
 Accept and adopt the Fiscal Year 2024 budget
- April 1, 2023 Begin Fiscal Year 2024

RE: Township Supervisor's Report

<u>HERE Program</u>: The Housing Eviction Relief Efforts (HERE) Program is in full swing. From November 29, 2022 through January 17, 2023, Township has dispersed from the General Town Fund approximately \$35,500 towards rent, mortgage, and utilities, successfully averting 26 clients from impending eviction. These dollars are in addition to what has been disbursed from the General Assistance Fund.

<u>General Assistance</u>: In December 2022, ninety-five applicants sought Township services. Of those, forty-three are *potentially eligible* for General Assistance and fifty-two are *potentially eligible* for Emergency Assistance.

No Supplemental Security Refunds were received in December.

Four Rural Township recipients received General Assistance. The Townships assisted include Bloomington, Danvers, and Dawson. Danvers Township received a Supplemental Security Refund which was processed through the City of Bloomington Township and remitted back to Danvers.

<u>Workfare Programs</u>: Three Wellness Lifestyle classes were held in December, two at The Junction and one at the Township building. On December 2, 2022, the class welcomed guest speaker Amy Humphreys from Heartland Community College who brought along Millie, an emotional support dog. Ms. Humphreys spoke about how Millie became a support dog and how Millie assists in therapy. For the remaining classes, Dr. Johnson discussed the importance of physical and mental well-being and concluded his overview of the Enneagram Personality Test results for those attendees who took the test in November.

As of January 2023, the Wellness classes have been suspended temporarily pending a revamp of the program. The clients who had been attending have been reassigned to other workfare programs.

POTS Recycling: POTS recycling bins have remained open for winter collection. The next pickup is scheduled for Friday January 20, 2023.

East Jordan Plastics, the Township's recycling vendor, picked up a full semi load of sorted pots on December 12, 2022. A total of 51,836 pounds (or approximately 26 tons) of horticultural plastics have been diverted from the Bloomington landfills since January 2020.

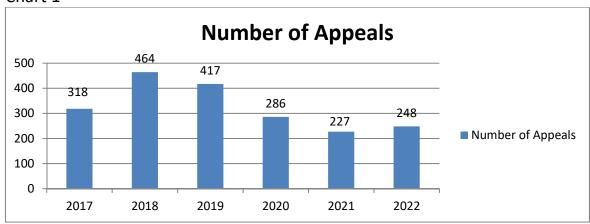
